1. WAIHĪ BEACH

Brunch at Eddie's and Elspeth

Just a few minutes' drive from downtown Mount Maunganui, Eddie's offers amazing coffee and delicious breakfasts while Elspeth Bakery offers speciality pastries made by skilled bakers on site. Yum.

Visit the container mall 'Our Place'

Our Place is a lively outdoor space with tasty street food, live music, craft beer, art and shops featuring local brands.

Take a Brewbus Tour
